### POSITION DETAILS

**TEAM LEADER (1 Position):** The Team Leader is the day to day supervisor for the Green Team. This person is responsible for the conduct of Team Members and the work they undertake. The Team Leader ensures that the work required is properly assigned and carried out, and that the project proceeds smoothly. This involves planning, maintaining discipline and safety, daily acquisition of project materials, effective communication with the Community Partner and CCNL staff, administrative duties etc. A Team Leader should demonstrate the ability to plan and organize, and must have leadership and supervisory skills. **This position is for 8 weeks, at \$17.35/hr for 35 hours per week, from June 29th to August 21st, 2026. This project requires work from Monday to Friday, with the possibility of some evening or weekend work.**

**TEAM MEMBER (3 Positions):** The Team Member is an integral part of the Green Team program.
